The STEM Major Project

Developed by Holmes to renovate STEM facilities with cutting-edge technology while incorporating activities and programs to promote STEM awareness, enrollment and degree completion.



NEH Infrastructure and Capacity Building Challenge Grant

The Foundation has a five-year plan to match the National Endowment for the Humanities grant with \$231.849, totaling \$463,698 over the life of the grant. These funds will provide the means for renovating the interior spaces of McMorrough Library in Goodman.

The late Henry B. McClellan Jr. of Goodman, MS, was known to his colleagues at Holmes as a solution finder. 





Earley "Elton" Calhoun, Jr., Football



The late Earley "Elton" Calhoun, Jr., is a native of Yazoo City, where he attended Yazoo City High School. Calhoun is being inducted into the Holmes Sports Hall of

Fame for his football accomplishments.

Calhoun attended Holmes 1964-1966 and played football under Charles Darnell, Ken Lauderdale and Robert McGraw. He was honorable mention at All-State in 1964 and 1965 but served as a co-captain at All-State in 1965. During Calhoun's years at Holmes, he was a member of Phi Theta Kappa and voted Most Versatile.



James E. Lehaman, Sr. is a native of Cruger and graduate of Tchula Attendance Center. Lehaman is being inducted into the Holmes

Sport Hall of Fame for basketball.

James E. Lehaman, Basketball

Lehaman played basketball at Holmes as low post from 1983-1985 under Bennie Kimble. In 1985, Lehaman was recognized as Mississippi Junior College Association All-State Honoree. After Holmes, Lehman attended Kentucky Christian University on a basketball scholarship.

Anthony Carlyle, Basketball



Anthony Carlyle graduated from Yazoo County High School and headed to Goodman to play basketball for Holmes Community College. Carlyle played

under Coach Todd Kimble in the 2003-2004 and 2004-2005 seasons.

As a player at Holmes, Carlyle played on some successful teams. In 2004, the men's basketball team record was 17-9 and 10-2 in the north division.

"I enjoyed building the relationships with the players from the other schools Holmes played on and off the court," Carlyle said.

Robert Pool, Coach



Hernando native Robert Pool will be inducted into the 2022 Sports Hall of Fame for his 18-year career as a football coach for the

Holmes Bulldogs.

After high school he earned a bachelor's and a master's degree from the University of Mississippi.

Pool took a position coaching football and baseball at Hernando High School after college where his teams played in two championship games for baseball.

James "Alton" Wright, Track & Field



James "Alton" Wright is a graduate of Kosciusko High School and attended Holmes from 1961-1963. Wright is being inducted into the Sports Hall of Fame

for his track and field accomplishments.

Wright had four brothers who also participated in sports at Holmes as well Elton (track), Hubert (football), Robert (football and baseball) and Hillary (track and baseball).

During Wright's time at Holmes, he ran the 880 yard relay and the mile relay. In 1963, the 880 yard relay team won first place at the state meet with a time of 1:32:75.




GANT TO BE INDUCTED IN THE MCCHOF
