

VA Acknowledgements

Must be submitted every semester

Workforce Development, Adult Education, and Ed2Go courses are NOT eligible for VA benefits. They are not for college credit, and are ineligible for financial aid. These courses are offered by a company outside of Holmes CC, and will not apply to the completion of an Associate degree, Associate of Applied Science degree, or a technical certificate.

It is my responsibility to verify I have met all Admissions and VA requirements before my enrollment certification can be sent to the VA Regional Office to begin benefits. This includes: admission application, submission of all official transcripts, and certification of eligibility (COE).

Payment for a short-term class will only be for the period in which the class is in session.

CH 33 and CH 31 students: if you receive any tuition and fee specific financial aid, it will impact your benefits.

Benefits are for approved programs ONLY. All courses must be required and listed on the degree plan, unless otherwise discussed with program advisor with documentation.

I will be responsible for charges for courses not required in my degree plan.

I must report any changes in enrollment (additions, audits, withdrawals, etc.) to the School Certifying Official ASAP. Failure to report changes may result in a debt, for which I am responsible.

Veterans Affairs will not pay for repeated courses which a grade of "D" or better has been previously assigned unless the program requires a "C" or better for acceptance.

I will not be certified for any remedial classes (Beginning English, Beginning Algebra, etc.) taken online or as hybrid. Therefore, I also understand that I am responsible for any charges for online/hybrid remedial courses.

Once the requirements for the Associate of Arts Degree have been met, VA will no longer pay for academic courses.

I understand to allow a third-party access to my VA Educational Benefit information, I must complete the Consent to Release of Student Information form (FERPA) form with the admissions office.

If I fail to meet Satisfactory Academic Progress, I will receive a letter explaining that you will be on probation for one semester for VA education benefits. You must meet the Standards of Progress by the end of the probation semester or be suspended from receiving VA benefits until you meet the Standards of Progress again. If you fail to meet these conditions, you will have to file an appeal in order to continue to receive your VA Benefits. If by chance, your appeal is denied you will not be eligible for any Federal Aid or VA educational benefits until you are back in good standing.
